I am writing in response to the letter you originally sent to the U. S. Department of Justice (DOJ), dated July 21, 2009, regarding potential substandard treatment and fraudulent acts by the Barrow Desert Medical Center, Barrows Neurological Institute, and St. Joseph's Hospital and Medical Center, involving the care your daughter Schaunell Roberson received at each facility.

Our office reviewed your correspondence and supporting documentation and determined that one of the issues you raised concerned the quality of care your daughter received. Accordingly, I have forwarded your correspondence to:

The Office of Inspector General is responsible for investigating fraud within the programs of the Department of Health and Human Services.
